Gate Access Card Responsibilities

- ▶ An Airport Gate Access Card (card) authorizes you to have access to the air operations area (AOA) of the Chico Municipal Airport. All airport cards are the property of the City of Chico and must be returned to the City when the card expires or at the conclusion of your need to access the AOA.
- ▶ As per City Fee Schedule 90.010 the fee for a Security Gate Reader Card is as follows:
 - Fee (two year period) - \$46
 - Replacement Fee for each card lost, stolen or damaged (due to abuse) cards - \$36
- ▶ You are responsible for your card. NEVER loan your card to anyone. The card is issued solely for your use. Please report a lost or stolen card to the City immediately by calling (530) 896-7200.
- ▶ There is a \$36.00 replacement fee if your card is lost, stolen, or if it becomes inoperative due to misuse or abuse.
- ▶ Be aware of your surroundings. Always watch for running or moving aircraft, vehicles and equipment.
- ▶ Everyone working or operating on the airport must understand that they play a vital role in keeping the airport safe and secure by:
 - Ensuring the gate or door that you pass through closes securely behind you.
 - Ensuring that no one follows you through a gate or door unless that person is under your escort.
 - Immediately reporting any suspicious activity to the Chico Police Department at (530) 897-4911.
- ▶ Federal regulations, under 49 CFR 1542.209(1), impose a continuing obligation for you to disclose to the City, within 24 hours, if you are convicted of any disqualifying criminal offense that occurs while you have gate access privileges.

**Violations of any of the above rules can result in
revocation of your airport GATE ACCESS card.**
