Fridays, the Records Division will be **CLOSED** to the public for all services except processing Vehicle Releases, which will still be available. Records clerks will also be available Fridays to address administrative items for partnering law enforcement agencies. While the Records Division will be closed to the public, Records Clerks will continue to perform administrative duties, working select hours Friday, Saturday and Sunday.

The Chico Police Department's Records Clerks perform a host of regular duties in support of the public as well as for police officers. We encourage the public to take note of the new hours of operation to avoid conflicts in obtaining pertinent records information.
