Chico Police Community Survey

The community survey released on October 19, 2011 regarding policing issues will close in one week on January 12, 2012. The survey is intended to provide the Police Department with valuable feedback in several areas. To date about 460 surveys have been completed. The Chico Police Department would like to take this opportunity to again encourage citizens to take just a few moments to complete the survey and provide input on these very important issues. Chief of Police, Mike Maloney is hoping to:

1. Measure the community's level of satisfaction with the Chico Police Department;
2. Determine perceptions about safety in the City; and
3. Receive input regarding the prioritization of police services.
