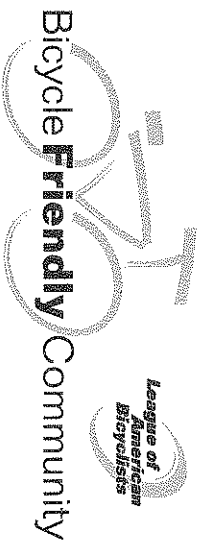
Your designation will be due for renewal in May of 2009. At that point your community will be reevaluated so we urge you to make as many improvements as possible in the meantime!
