

Code Enforcement Frequently Asked Questions

1. How do I report an abandoned vehicle?
**If on private property, call Code Enforcement at 879-6330.
If on the public street, call the Police Department at 897-4970.**
2. How do I report graffiti?
Call the Graffiti Hotline at 898-2003.
3. How do I report illegal dumping that is taking place right now in the City limits?
Call Code Enforcement at 879-6330 or after hours, the police at 897-4900.
4. How do I report illegal dumping that has already taken place in the City limits?
**If it is on private property, it is the property owner's responsibility.
If it is on the public right-of-way, call the Public Works Department/Operations & Maintenance at 894-4200.**
5. What does or does not require a city building permit?
Call the Building Division at 879-6700.
6. Why do I need to make the repairs? My tenant is responsible for the problem.
The property owner is ultimately responsible for all repairs to their property.
7. What happens after I receive a notice from the City to correct code violations?
The responsible party has however many days the code enforcement officer has given them on the notice to comply. They will then follow up. If compliance is met, the case is closed. If compliance is not met, the responsible party may be charged a fine by issuance of a citation.
8. Where can I post "For Sale" or yard sale signs?
It is prohibited to post any signs on public property such as lamp posts, sidewalks, and street sign posts. You must obtain the permission of the property owner in order to post signs on private property.
