TRAIL USE IN BIDWELL PARK

The proper use of trails is an important issue in keeping Bidwell Park healthy. Protecting the Bidwell Park trail system depends on public support. Unauthorized trail building or making trail modifications is strictly prohibited. Individuals or groups interested in working on trail building or repair should join the Park Division efforts during the regularly scheduled trail work seasons. Check the City of Chico website (www.ci.chico.ca.us) for volunteer trail work days.

The Park trail crew follows in depth guidelines in planning trail projects, repair and maintenance. These efforts help protect and maintain Bidwell Park's over 80 miles of trails and visitor's observance of trail open or closure signs during wet weather provides a safer experience that minimizes adverse impacts to sensitive resources within the park.
